



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

Q. When and where do you play?

A. We meet on Thursday evenings at 7.15pm for a 7.25pm start (doors open at 7.00pm). We play at the Fyfield Village Hall, Houchin Drive, Fyfield, ESSEX. CM5 0RG. We are located approximately 10 miles west of Chelmsford.

Q. How big is the hall where you play?

A. The hall can accommodate up to 50 tables

Q. How easy is it to park?

A. Space is always available in the car park which is adjacent to the Hall.

Q. What about refreshments?

A. Tea and Coffee and home made cake is available from 7.00 pm and during the 15 minute break.

Q. How many people play at the Club?

A. The number of tables generally averages 8/9 each week

Q. Are all your members local?

A. Most members come from Fyfield, Ongar and surrounding villages.

Q. What is the standard of play at the club?

A. The standard of play at the Club are early learners, improvers and intermediate level.

Q. Does the Club offer Bridge Tuition?

A. Yes. The Club has successfully runs Beginners and Intermediate Courses (following the EBU structured programmes and Supervised Bridge Sessions and Workshops. The Club only uses fully qualified and experienced EBU Tutors to conduct the Bridge Courses. Please refer to Tuition for current offerings.

Q. Do I have to have a regular partner to play at the Club?

A. No. We do have a Partner Hosting system in operation on an as needs and as available arrangement. See the Contact Section on the Website of who to contact if you require a Bridge Partner.

Q. Is the Club affiliated to the English Bridge Union (EBU)

A. No but the Club Manager keeps abreast of EBU activities and has this under review as the Club develops.

Q. Do I have to be an EBU Member to play at the Club?

A. No – we welcome all bridge players.

Q. How much does it cost to join the Club/Play each week?
