

Intermediate Bridge Course – Tuesday, 21st September 2010 – 2.00pm to 4.00pm

Aims of the Course

The aim of the course is to provide informative but enjoyable classes and will consist of tuition and play and there will be a 10 minute tea/coffee break during the class.

Class numbers are limited to 16 delegates to ensure adequate Tutor supervision.

The classes follow the EBU Bridge For All Programme using Book Two – Continuing Bridge. ‘Bridge for All’ is a staged learning programme produced by the EBU, the national body that looks after the game of Duplicate Bridge in England. The EBU has standardised the many different bidding systems to one standard system; Standard English. Standard English is based on Acol Weak No Trumps. You can therefore be assured you will be learning the most current and accepted Bridge system there is and is being delivered by an experienced EBUTA Qualified Teacher.

The Intermediate Course assumes delegates have the knowledge of the material covered in Book 1 – Beginning Bridge and the course will enable you to consolidate what you should know already, be introduced to more advanced Bidding and Play techniques and at the end of the course you should be able to play a competent game of Bridge at an Improver friendly Bridge Club.

Who the Course is Suitable For

The Course is suitable for anyone who has played Bridge before and wants to learn more advanced Bidding and Play methods and generally wants to up-date themselves on the current Bidding and Play techniques.

Course Duration, Times, Venue and Cost

The course is a 30 week course and commences on Tuesday, 21st September, 2010 and all classes start at 2.00pm and finish at 4.00pm. The course is held at Fyfield Village Hall, Houchin Drive, Fyfield, ESSEX. CM5 0RG

The cost of the Course is £160.00 per delegate (£65 cheaper than Adult Education and other Training Providers) and this can be paid for in 2 installments of £80.00. You will need to purchase the course book which is £25.00. If you attend the Bridge Course with your partner it is quite acceptable to share the course book and therefore you will only need to purchase 1 book.
